- A team building and personal development opportunity for Eco/School Councillors.
- Between 3 and 6 schools involved in total, comprising a minimum of 4 children to a maximum of 10 from each school, with one accompanying adult from each.
- A programme of activities using the Eco Schools themes, led by CEES specialist teachers, and designed to inspire children and equip them with Eco Schools ideas to take back to school.
- Arrival at around 9.30 on day one, departure at around 4.00 on day two.
- A chance for children to share their Eco Schools activities with others.
- A charge of £60 per child for the two-day experience, including tuition, accommodation, equipment and materials, plus all meals from lunch on day one through to lunch on day two. No charge for accompanying adults.
