Eco Schools Inspiration



- More than 100 local schools have registered with the National Eco Schools Green Flag Award scheme and 10 have achieved their Green Flag, including Somersham Primary, host school for this event.
- Following a reassessment, CEES' Centre at Stibbington has been awarded its third Green Flag and 4 members of CEES' teaching team are qualified Eco Schools Assessors.
- A CEES workshop to be held in November will share good practice and provide guidance for those who are interested in Eco Schools.
- The session will run from 4 until 6pm and will focus on **energy education** and **carbon footprinting**, including the **Carbon Detectives** programme. This programme is being operated in the UK by BRE. It will engage pupils and teachers in fun, interactive activities that help schools to become more sustainable, while delivering Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) elements into the curriculum and sharing experiences with other schools.
- There will also be a brief introduction to the Eco Schools Award scheme and an opportunity for representatives of Somersham Primary School to share their work.
