

CEES Fee Structure September 2011 to July 2012

Fees quoted below are for Cambridgeshire Local Authority schools
and Non-Cambridgeshire CEES Subscribers

DAY COURSES for pupils: All CEES day courses are designed to enrich the curriculum for every child. Courses are tutored by CEES' specialist, experienced, qualified teachers. Fees are based on a ratio of one member of CEES staff per class of up to 34 pupils, with free places for adults at CEES' recommended ratios. 2 classes may be accommodated daily at Stibbington and one class daily at Burwell House, Wisbech Castle and Coldham Wind Farm.

Stibbington Centre, Burwell House, Wisbech Castle: £290 per class

KS2 Evacuation and Victorian Days at Stibbington: add £1.50 per pupil for a "period" lunch.

Coldham Wind Farm Energy Works day courses & workshops in schools: **no charge**

- All course programmes are planned jointly by school staff with centre staff, and all **tuition** is by CEES' specialist, experienced, qualified, teachers.
- 3-day courses run from around 9.30 on Monday/Wednesday to around 2.30 on Wednesday/Friday.
- Maximum group size** is 34 pupils plus 4 adults. Adult places are free at a ratio of 1 : 8.
- With the exception of Special Schools, where group size is less than 20 there will be a **minimum charge** equivalent to the fee for 20 pupils.
- New for 2011 - 12, **bursaries of up to £30 per eligible child** are available from the Stibbington Centre Greener Futures Trust. An application form for completion by Headteachers is available.
- Schools may be able to offer to fund a **further reduction** to those pupils who are eligible for free school meals, equivalent to 3 (5) times the cost of the lunches that will not be provided by the school.
- Where a single booking spans two charging periods the lower rate will apply.
- Some programmes may incur a small additional charge, for example where a minibus is required.
