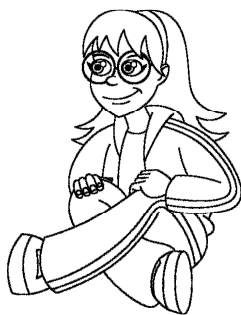
Art Attack

General information and booking conditions

- ◆ To reserve places on our summer holiday activity sessions, the booking form overleaf should be completed and returned to Stibbington Centre with a cheque (payable to Cambridgeshire County Council) or full cash payment. A receipt will be supplied.
- ◆ Payment is non-refundable unless we have to cancel.
- ◆ Prior to the event we will send you confirmation of your booking and a consent form.
- ◆ Unless you request a postal mailing, communication from Stibbington will be by email. The booking form asks for your email address.
- ◆ Children should be delivered to registration at the start of their first session by their carer who MUST bring the completed consent form. We cannot accept any child on an activity without the signed consent form or with an incomplete consent form.
- ◆ If your child has any mobility, medical or behavioural conditions that we should be aware of in advance of the first session, details should be submitted in writing with the booking form.
- ◆ Stibbington Centre reserves the right to exclude any child we feel is a danger to either themselves or others. Parents / carers must ensure that it will be possible to arrange this if necessary.
- ◆ A drink and biscuit will be provided mid-session.
- ◆ Where children are attending the morning session and staying for the afternoon session, a packed lunch may be brought, and supervision will be provided at lunchtime at no extra charge.
- ◆ T-shirts bearing the logo "The Stibbington Adventure" are available at £5 (children's sizes) or £7 (adults) and may be ordered in advance. Choose from Navy, Black, Red, Royal.
- ◆ A souvenir shop will be open at the end of the morning and start of the afternoon session. We will restrict shoppers' spending to a maximum of £1 per day.
- ◆ Closing date for bookings: Tuesday 12 July.
- ◆ Places are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.
