Method 1

Using Developer

The paper has a white side and a cream (shiny) side

1. Put your name on the white side
2. Put you leaf on a paper towel (bumpy/vein side up)
- 3 Brush with developer (red tray)
(Not too wet but well covered.
Blot to get spare liquid away)
4. Make a sandwich:
paper (shiny side)/leaf (wet side down)/paper
towel
5. Squash for 1 minute
6. Take away the towel
7. Use tongs to transfer to the fixer (white tray)
(Leave for at least 1 minute)
8. Rinse in the water
9. Put aside to dry

Method 2

Using Fixer

The paper has a white side and a cream (shiny) side

1. Put your name on the white side
2. Put you leaf on a paper towel (bumpy/vein side up)
3. Brush with fixer (white tray)
(Not too wet but well covered.
Blot to get spare liquid away)
4. Make a sandwich:
paper (shiney side)/leaf (wet side down)/paper towel
5. Squash for 1 minute
6. Take away the towel
7. Put in the developer (red tray) until black
8. Use tongs to wash in the water
9. Put in the fixer (white tray)
10. Put aside to dry

Method 3

Using Sunlight

The paper has a white side and a cream (shiny) side

1. Put your name on the white side
2. Put your leaf face up on the paper
3. Put the paper on a board
4. Put a piece of glass over the leaf and paper
5. Secure the glass with bulldog clips
6. Put the board outside on a table in the sunlight
7. Leave until the light has darkened the paper
8. Remove from the board,
Take away the leaf and place in the fixer (white tray)
(Leave for at least 1 minute)
9. Wash in the water
10. Set aside to dry
