The CEES team at Stibbington Centre would like to invite interested Heads and teachers to sign up to a special **SCIENCE GREEN DAY** for KS2 children. The programme is designed to support the British Science Week theme of 'Exploration and discovery' and to inspire teams of Eco Councillors or School Councillors to begin to work together and return to school enthused with new ideas.

Cars, minibuses and coaches are asked to deliver their groups to our check-in point at Stibbington Centre between 9.30 and 9.45.

At the Centre CEES teachers will be poised to lead a programme of science based eco-activities. Pupils will take part in three sessions – **Marvellous Mini-beasts, Wonderful Willow and Superb Sunlight**. The day's programme will end at 2.30.

Our target group size is 8 key stage 2 children accompanied by one or two adults, and our charge per group will be £80 per group. This charge includes an **eco-lunch** as well as all activities on the day. Subject to availability, schools might nominate more than one group to benefit from the day, selecting for example:

- Those who qualify for Pupil Premium
- Eco Council
- School Council
- Gardening club
- Representatives from the class(es) currently working on an environmental theme

or simply those young people who deserve a treat.
