The emphasis of the workshops, which are designed to support the National Curriculum, will be on practical, "hands-on" learning activities suitable for use in any school grounds.

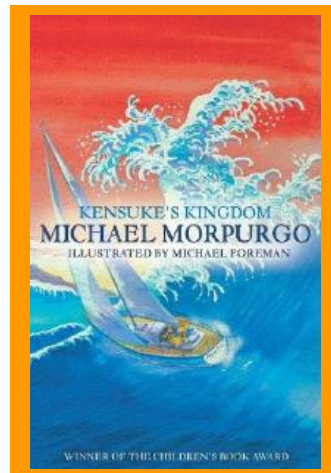
